FOUR-DAY/THREE-NIGHT SAMPLE ITINERARY

Recommended for a weekend. Timing and itinerary are flexible

THURSDAY

11 a.m.

Meet Grapevine Tour Guide at the Grapevine Convention & Visitors Bureau, 636 S. Main Street, for Step-On Guided Tour of **Historic Main Street District**.

11:30 a.m.

Take in the magnificent 360-degree view of the surrounding Grapevine area with the **Grapevine Observation Tower Tour** at Grapevine Main Station.

Noon

Enjoy lunch at **Harvest Hall**, a European-style food hall designed after the grand train stations of the 19th century.

1 p.m.

Depart Harvest Hall for the **Gaylord Texan Resort**. Explore this beautiful resort on your own, where you'll find highlights from across Texas all under a glass atrium.

3 p.m.

Check into your Grapevine hotel* and take a little time to refresh before your evening dinner.

5 p.m.

The Grapevine CVB can assist you with group dining options.

FRIDAY

10 a.m.

Explore the **Settlement to City Museums** as it traces the history of Grapevine from the earliest settlers to current day. Groups can also print their own postcard on a 19th century printing press for an additional \$5.

11 a.m.

Experience an old-fashioned social or interactive craft program at Historic **Nash Farm**, the oldest operating farmstead in Tarrant County.

12:30 p.m.

Enjoy lunch and shopping in the Historic Main Street District, with more than 80 local shops, bistros and cafés, galleries, winery-tasting rooms and much more.

3 p.m.

Enjoy a wine tasting at one of **Grapevine's Winery Tasting Rooms** (*to be set-up by the Grapevine CVB*).

4 p.m.

Return to host hotel to relax and refresh.

5 p.m.

This evening, we recommend dinner with an entertaining, comical "whodunit" show at the **Texas Star Dinner Theatre** or take a night time excursion on Main Street with the **Grapevine Night Watchman Ghost Tour** **dinner not included with tour.*

SATURDAY

9:30 a.m.

Take in the natural beauty and tranquil surroundings of nature at the **Grapevine Botanical Gardens**.

11 a.m.

Dine in Grapevine's original filling station at **Willhoite's Restaurant**, complete with the original gas pump out front and a Model T Ford hanging over the Texas-sized buffet.

12:30 p.m.

Board the **Grapevine Vintage Railroad** at the Historic Cotton Belt Depot. If time allows, we recommend popping into **Vetro Glassblowing Studio & Gallery** or **Holder Dane Gallery**.

12:50 p.m.

The Grapevine Vintage Railroad departs for the Historic **Fort Worth Stockyards**.

2:30 p.m.

Enjoy the Historic Stockyards with shopping, dining and western heritage attractions.

4 p.m.

Witness a live cattle drive as the Fort Worth Herd makes its way through the Historic Stockyards.

4:35 p.m.

Board the Grapevine Vintage Railroad to return to Grapevine.

4:45 p.m.

The Grapevine Vintage Railroad departs for Grapevine.

7 p.m.

Estimated arrival of the Grapevine Vintage Railroad in Grapevine.
