Trinity River Train Excursion – 45-minute excursion starts and ends in the Historic Stockyards, \$10 – \$14

Planes & Trains Guided Tour – This three-part, three-hour tour takes visitors to the top of the Grapevine Observation Tower, followed by a one-hour excursion aboard the Grapevine Vintage Railroad.
