GRAPEVINE PUBLIC ART TRAIL



Perched atop Grapevine City Hall, the Grapevine Nightwatchman statue, created by artist Jack Bryant and dedicated in 1998, keeps watch over Historic Main Street. This 8-foot tall, 640-pound tribute honors Grapevine's original lawmen, who patrolled the town at night, lit street lamps, checked store locks and even served as dog catchers. 200 S. Main St.
