**Grapevine Bear Creek Short Line** – 90-minute excursion starts and ends in Grapevine, \$10 – \$12, FREE parking

**Cotton Belt Route** – Begins and ends in Grapevine and travels to the Historic Stockyards, with two hours to explore on foot before returning to Grapevine, \$18 – \$26, \$72, FREE parking

**Trinity River Train Excursion** – 45-minute excursion starts and ends in the Historic Stockyards, \$10 – \$14

### GRAPEVINE PUBLIC ART TRAIL



Step back in time with this vibrant mural located at the **Grapevine Masonic Lodge #288**. Created in 2009 by artist Jorge D'Soria, the mural celebrates famous Freemasons like George Washington, Benjamin Franklin and William B. Travis.
