

Fun Facts


- Desert Hot Springs' more than 20 boutique mineral water spa resorts and hideaways have earned it the nickname: "California's Spa City."

- The Festival Lawn is the home of on-going and special events in Downtown Cathedral City between the Mary Pickford Theatre and the Desert Cinemas UltraMAX.



La Quinta charms visitors from around the world with phenomenal golf at PGA WEST, La Quinta Resort & Club and SilverRock Resort while outdoor aficionados explore the scenic trails of the Santa Rosa Mountains; art lovers indulge in the abundance of art and culture; and everyone enjoys fabulous dining, shopping and hospitality.

- La Quinta boasts a variety of shopping and restaurants along the bustling Highway 111 corridor and in Old Town La Quinta, a charming village-style destination filled with unique boutiques and bistros.
- A Sunday farmers market and Saturday art show, Art on Main Street, take place in Old Town for several months of the year.
- La Quinta Arts Festival, held each spring, has been ranked the #1 fine art festival in the country and attracts thousands of art-lovers from around the world.

- The Palm Springs Aerial Tramway, with rotating tramcars, takes visitors on one of the steepest ascents in the world to elevation 8,200 feet and 54 miles of hiking trails. The 10-minute ride to the top reveals 30-degree temperature drops, as well as winter snow.
- Every Thursday night, vibrant Palm Canyon Drive is transformed into VillageFest, an outdoor festival of food, music, arts and crafts and more.
- The Palm Springs Indian Canyons are filled with trails for hiking or horseback riding, lush oases, natural water formations and historic remnants of the early Aqua Caliente Band of Indians who inhabited the area.



Known as the "City of Festivals," Indio is as much at home with agriculture as world recognized entertainment, blue-blooded polo tournaments (including night polo) and gaming. The increasing popularity of the Coachella Valley Music & Arts Festival and Stagecoach Music Festival, as well as the Riverside County Fair and National Date Festival, Southwest Arts Festival and International Tamale Festival, attract many thousands of visitors each year.

- Favorite Indio attractions include Empire Polo Club, Fantasy Springs Resort Casino, Coachella Valley
- Shields Date Garden, established in 1924, is a desert icon. The store with date gardens features many varieties of the delicious and healthy snacks for tasting and buying, as well as a popular café starring dates.

Fun Facts


- Sunnylands, the former estate of US Ambassador and special events are offered at select times with advance ticket reservations.

Celebrating its multi-generational Mexican American culture with annual events, Coachella is also home to a popular farmers market featuring plentiful crops, such as grapes, citrus, corn, carrots, artichokes and peppers. Coachella marks the easternmost city in Greater Palm Springs and has a rich cultural heritage to explore.

Fun Facts

- Coachella is home to some of the area's best, authentic Mexican restaurants.
- Together with neighboring cities Indio, Thermal and Mecca, Coachella produces 95 percent of the nation's dates.
- Downtown Walking Tour guides visitors to the city's murals, art displays, filming sites and historical structures.



Palm Desert is a cultural, educational and retail center featuring the "Rodeo Drive of the Desert"—El Paseo. The city also claims the renowned McCallum Theatre, The Living Desert, excellent hiking trails, beautiful golf resorts and shopping for every taste.

Fun Facts

- The nation's only citywide Golf Cart Parade is held in Palm Desert each October, drawing about 25,000 spectators who watch more than 100 creatively decorated golf carts travel down El Paseo.
- College of the Desert Street Fair, a collection of clothing, crafts, food, music and vendors, is held in Palm Desert each Saturday and Sunday morning.
- The Palm Springs Art Museum in Palm Desert features ongoing and temporary exhibitions of internationally recognized art in different media.
- On "First Weekends of the Month," November-May, the city offers art walks and an assortment of entertainment, from gallery exhibits to a popular cruise night.


