Crisp air, golden leaves, and cozy charm – discover autumn’s magic in Greenville County.



## THE VILLAGE GRIND

*1258 Pendleton St, Greenville, SC 29611*

Start your romantic fall weekend with breakfast at The Village Grind — cozy, candlelit, and perfect for a crisp autumn morning. Then head north on 276 to Bald Rock Heritage Preserve, where sweeping views of the Upstate unfold beneath a golden canopy.



## BALD ROCK HERITAGE PRESERVE

*280 Persimmon Ridge Rd, Cleveland, SC 29635*

Just 30 minutes from downtown Greenville, Bald Rock offers sweeping panoramas of Table Rock framed by autumn color. Pack a blanket and a camera — it’s one of the Upstate’s most photogenic fall overlooks.



## VICTORIA VALLEY VINEYARD

*1360 S Saluda Rd, Cleveland, SC 29635*

Tucked in the heart of the Blue Ridge foothills, Victoria Valley brings a touch of Europe to South Carolina. Share a tasting flight under the pergola, surrounded by grapevines glowing in amber light. Their café offers locally inspired fare — think charcuterie, flatbreads, and the perfect glass of Merlot for a crisp fall afternoon.



## CAESARS HEAD STATE PARK

*8155 Geer Hwy, Cleveland, SC 29635*

Take the scenic drive up Highway 276 toward Caesars Head; a route made for leaf peeping and hand-in-hand hikes. Stop at overlooks like Bald Knob or Raven Cliff Falls for a quiet moment surrounded by fiery red and gold treetops.



## HOTEL DOMESTIQUE & RESTAURANT 17

*10 Rd of Vines, Travelers Rest, SC 29690*

Check in at Hotel Domestique — a French-inspired boutique escape founded by Tour de France legend George Hincapie. With only a handful of rooms, it’s private, elegant, and ideal for couples. Dinner at Restaurant 17 is a must: seasonal ingredients, fireside dining, and vineyard views create an unforgettable evening.
