


- Guam Premier Outlets (GPO):

Practical Information for Your Clients

Smooth Sailing: Visa & Entry Requirements

- U.S. Visa Required: Filipino citizens need a valid U.S. non-immigrant visa (B1/B2 tourist visa) to travel to Guam.
- Application Process: Apply in advance via U.S. Embassy Manila (DS-160, fee, interview).
- Passport Validity: 6 months beyond stay.
- Electronic Guam Customs
 Declaration Form: Mandatory,
 complete online (up to) 72 hrs prior.



Know Before You Go: Practicalities

- Currency: United States Dollar (USD).
 ATMs & credit cards widely accepted.
- Language: English & CHamoru (official). Japanese/Korean understood in tourist areas. Encourage "Håfa Adai!"
- Best Time to Visit:
 - Dry Season (Dec-Jun): Peak, sunny, low humidity. Jan-May ideal.
 - Wet Season (Jul-Nov): More showers, lower prices, fewer crowds.
 - Typhoon Season (late Aug-Nov): Advise travel insurance.



Getting Around & Where to Stay

• Flights:

 Philippine Airlines and United Airlines fly direct from Manila to Guam daily.

o Transportation:

- Rental Cars: Highly recommended for independence.
- Taxis & Ride-Sharing: Available.
- Hotel Shuttles & Trolley Buses: Convenient for tourist areas.

Accommodation Options:

- Luxury Resorts: Located in Tumon Bay.
- Mid-Range Hotels: Good value.
- Budget-Friendly Options: Guesthouses.
- Serviced Apartments: For longer stays/families.



Ensuring a Safe & Respectful Trip

- General Safety: Safe destination, normal precautions.
- Sun Protection & Hydration:
 Essential in tropical climate.
- Ocean Safety: Beware of strong currents, swim in designated areas.
- Medical Facilities: Modern hospitals, travel insurance recommended.
- Emergency Number: 911.
- Local Etiquette: Respect for elders, using "Håfa Adai," modest dress at religious sites, tipping customary.


