



FISHERS TRAILS & LOOPS

See these loops and parks on the reverse side

Cheeney Creek Loop - 3.5 miles (family/beginner)

Points of interest: Cheeney Creek Natural Area, Nickel Plate District

Heritage Park Loop - 8.1 miles (advanced)

Points of interest: Heritage Park, White River, The Historic Ambassador House, Nickel Plate District

•Holland Park Loop - 2.3 miles (family/beginner)

Points of interest: Roy G. Holland Memorial Park, Nickel Plate District

Ritchey Woods Loop - 5.5 miles (advanced)

Points of interest: Ritchey Woods Nature Preserve, Nickel Plate District

•Saxony Beach Loop - 8.2 miles (advanced)

Note: The pedestrian crossing light, just south of HSE high school, is the best way to cross Olio Road. Points of interest: Bee Camp Creek Trailhead, Saxony Beach, Hamilton Southeastern High School, Fall Creek Intermediate School
