### HISTORIC NOBLESVILLE SQUARE

Start by parking near the Historic Noblesville Square. Offering cafes, restaurants, ice cream, shops, antiques and host to many special events. Be sure to snap a picture of this instagram-worthy spot.



### NOBLESVILLE BIKE SHARE

Coming in 2018, experience a way to see the sights of Noblesville through a bike share program. Standard cruiser bikes are available to rent. To rent a bike from the Noblesville Bike Share download the Zagster app.

### NOBLESVILLE VISITOR CENTER

Looking for more to do? Stop by the Noblesville Visitors Center for some inspiration.

### BRIDGE OVER WHITE RIVER

Pass by the Nickel Plate Railroad tracks and cross the White River on the boardwalk bridge.

### Downtown Noblesville

Be sure to stop on the bridge for a picturesque view of downtown Noblesville and the Hamilton County Courthouse.

### FOREST PARK

Cruise through Forest Park and be sure to check out the carousel, Tom Thumb mini golf course and Forest Park Golf Course.

### FOREST PARK AQUATIC CENTER

Cool off at the outdoor aquatic center that features an Olympic-sized pool and a multi-level diving platform.

### POTTER'S BRIDGE PARK

Continue on to Potter's Bridge Park to see the county's only remaining covered bridge that is listed in the National Register of Historic Places.

### MORSE BEACH & PARK

Make your way to Morse Beach & Park to relax, play on the aqua adventure park or enjoy a round of disc golf.
