

Kenosha Area: Feeling Adventurous 2 Day Summer Tour



ARRIVAL DAY 1

11:00 AM – Start your visit with lunch. Take your pick; many Kenosha Area restaurants have space for groups.

1:00 PM – Traverse through 120 elements at **Boundless Adventures**, an outdoor aerial adventure park at Bristol Woods Park. Crawl, swing, climb, balance, and zip-line through the forest! Bus parking is available. To take advantage of discounted group rates, reservations must be booked at least 14 days in advance.

5:00 PM – Check into one of Kenosha's premier hotels. Enjoy dinner before, during, or after your evening entertainment.

6 PM – Enjoy a free outdoor concert in a park, free entertainment at a biergarten, a **Kenosha Kingfish** baseball game, or a free **Aquanut Water Show**.

DAY 2

4:30 AM – Meet your **Kenosha Charter Boat Association** captain at Simmons Island Marina (multiple boats can be reserved for your group; choose a five or six hour outing).

5:00 AM – Depart the marina and watch the sun start to peek over the horizon. You'll cruise out about seven miles. Your Captain and crew will start setting bait and casting lines for you. Learn about Lake Michigan and the fishing history in the Kenosha Area, watch the lines bobbing in the water, and reel in fish. You can expect to catch Lake and Brown Trout, King and Coho Salmon, as well as a few other varieties on occasion. The crew will help you every step of the way — from teaching you how to reel in fish to netting your catch for you.

10:00 AM – Captains will start to clean your catch as you continue to fish.

10:30 AM – Your boat will head back to shore and your filets will be bagged for you to take home or for you to take to **Fin and Ale**, a local restaurant that offers the Shore Lunch – you catch 'em, they'll cook 'em! Also ask about their smoking services. The crew will share some of their favorite recipes and freezing tips with you on the ride back, too.

11:00 AM – You'll disembark the boat and be on your way to enjoying fresh Lake Michigan fish - whether at **Fin and Ale** or later at home.
