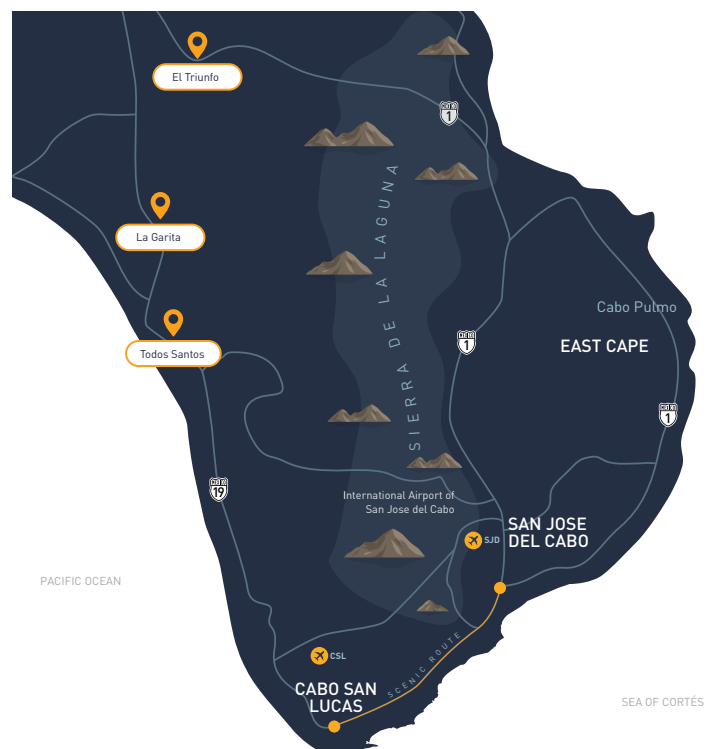
A JOURNEY INTO BAJA CALIFORNIA SUR'S MINING LEGACY

The town's rich deposits of gold and silver, which were mined as early as 1768, made it the most populous area in the state, boasting over 10,000 residents at its peak and serving as a crucial pillar of the Mexican economy.

The town is home to iconic landmarks such as *La Ramona*, an impressive chimney believed to be designed by Gustave Eiffel, and the *Museo Ruta de Plata*, which showcases a collection of mining artifacts and the geological treasures of the area. Beyond its historical significance, *El Triunfo* offers a unique blend of cultural, gastronomic, and natural experiences that connect visitors to the rich heritage and the enduring spirit of this vibrant community.

From exploring the *Museo del Vaquero Californiano*, participating in hands-on workshops at local artisan cooperatives, to hiking scenic trails with stunning views, *El Triunfo* provides a captivating backdrop for incentive travel that emphasizes community engagement, team building, and sustainable tourism. The town's commitment to preserving its cultural legacy and

supporting local craftsmanship makes it an ideal destination for those seeking a deeper connection to the authentic *Baja California Sur* experience.





DAY TRIP ITINERARY FOR EL TRIUNFO

7:30 AM – DEPARTURE FROM LOS CABOS:

Embark on a scenic drive from *Los Cabos*, heading north along the Pacific coast. The journey takes you past the charming town of *Todos Santos*.



8:45 AM – STOP AT LA GARITA REGIONAL HUB:

Make a stop at *La Garita*, a renowned regional restaurant hub known for its authentic Baja Californian cuisine and locally produced goods. Enjoy a light breakfast with traditional dishes such as *machaca*, freshly made *quesadillas*, and *tamales*. Take this opportunity to purchase local products like handmade *salsas*, jams, and artisanal crafts, supporting the local economy.



10:30 AM – ARRIVAL AT EL TRIUNFO AND VISIT TO MUVACA - MUSEO DEL VAQUERO DE LAS CALIFORNIAS:

Begin your exploration at the Muvaca Museum, which offers a deep dive into the rich history of *Baja California Sur* and its ranching culture. Watch an introductory video that sets the context for your visit, detailing the development of the region and the life of the cowboys and miners who shaped its history. Participate in a tortilla-making workshop in the museum's *Las Alforjas* kitchen, where local cooks will guide you through the process of making this staple of regional cuisine.



11:30 AM – COOKING CLASS AND LUNCH AT LAS ALFORJAS:

Participate in a cooking class at *Las Alforjas*, located within the *Museo del Vaquero Californiano*. Learn to prepare traditional dishes such as *quesadillas* with local cheese, *tamales*, and *machaca*. Enjoy a hearty lunch featuring the dishes you've helped create, while soaking in the rustic charm of this historic setting.



11:30 AM – VISIT TO MUSEO RUTA DE PLATA:

Continue your journey at the *Museo Ruta de Plata*, dedicated to the history of silver mining in the region. Explore the exhibits showcasing artifacts, photographs, and tools used during the town's mining heyday. Learn about the rise and fall of *El Triunfo* as a mining powerhouse and the ongoing efforts to preserve this legacy.





12:30 PM – EXPLORATION OF LA RAMONA AND THE MINING CHIMNEYS, AND GUIDED HIKE TO EL MIRADOR:

Take a guided walking tour of the mining chimneys, including the iconic *La Ramona*, designed by Gustave Eiffel. The tour will lead you past the ruins of old mining operations and the English cemetery, offering a glimpse into the lives of those who lived and worked in this once-thriving town. Continue up to *El Mirador*, the highest point in *El Triunfo*, for breathtaking panoramic views of the surrounding mountains and desert.



1:30 PM – LUNCH AT TOTO FRITO:

Enjoy a sustainable seafood lunch at *Toto Frito*, a restaurant known for its dishes featuring farmed totoaba, an endemic and protected species of the Gulf of California. Indulge in a variety of flavors, from traditional fish tacos to innovative sashimi dishes, while supporting conservation efforts for this unique fish species.



3:00 PM – FREE TIME & LOCAL CRAFT SHOPPING:

Enjoy some free time to explore the town at your own pace. Visit the local shops to purchase handmade leather goods, traditional sweets, and artisanal crafts. You can also take a moment to visit the historic *Capilla de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe*, a charming church that has been a spiritual center of the community for over a century.



If time allows, explore *Pico Pala Tours*' offerings, which include guided hikes and mountain biking excursions through the scenic trails connecting *El Triunfo* and *San Antonio*. This is an excellent opportunity for team-building activities that foster a deeper connection to the region's natural and cultural heritage.

4:30 PM – RETURN TO LOS CABOS:

Conclude your day with a relaxing drive back to *Los Cabos*. Take with you not only handcrafted souvenirs and memories of an enriching cultural experience but also a deeper understanding of the region's heritage and the impact of sustainable tourism on its communities.



5:45 PM – ARRIVAL IN LOS CABOS:
