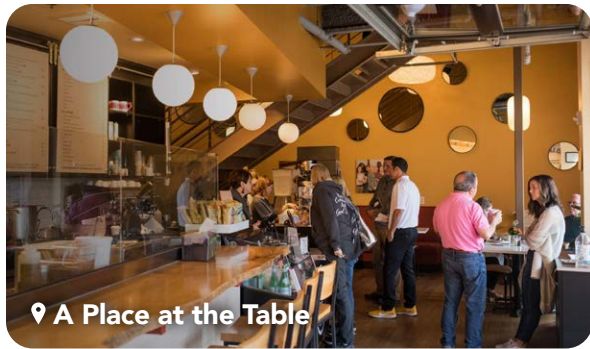

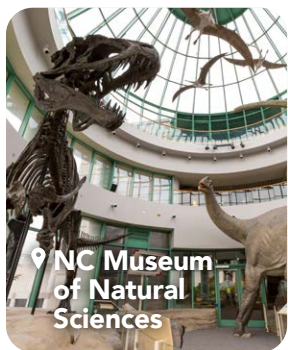

📍 **NC Museum of Natural Sciences** With four floors of exhibits, live animals, 3D movies, gift stores and two cafes, this is the largest natural science museum in the Southeast. The museum's "Dueling Dinos" exhibit features two of the most complete skeletons ever discovered of a Triceratops and Tyrannosaur. This fossil features the world's most complete Tyrannosaur skeleton – and is responsible for the groundbreaking discovery of the Nanotyrannus species. **FREE**

📍 **NC Museum of Art and Museum Park** Check out more than 5,000 historic and modern works of art at the NC Museum of Art. This museum is home to the Southeast's largest collection of Rodin sculptures, 164 acres of woodland walking trails and the unforgettable 📍 **Ann and Jim Goodnight Museum Park**. **FREE**

📍 **Sam Jones BBQ** Third-generation pitmaster Sam Jones' MICHELIN Bib Gourmand eatery in downtown Raleigh is rooted in North Carolina's traditional whole-hog barbecue style and tried-and-true Southern staples.

📍 **Brewery Bhavana** A hybrid flower shop-bookstore-craft brewery-dim sum restaurant with a MICHELIN Recommendation. This downtown establishment embodies Raleigh's knack for unexpected fusion and was named one of Bon Appétit's "The Hot 10" of Best New Restaurants in America when it opened.

📍 **Videri Chocolate Factory** Bean-to-bar chocolate factory with mouthwatering bites and a free behind-the-scenes tour of the chocolate-making process.

📍 **Raleigh Iron Works** Step into the industrial-chic Raleigh Iron Works, where raw warehouse bones meet an eclectic mix of dining, shopping and art. Taste your way through craft-beer pours at **Ponysaurus Brewing Co.** and a rotating selection of Old-World wines at **St. Pierre Wine Bar**. Explore locally curated boutiques like **Flourish Market** or achieve new heights at Salvage Yard's **Triangle Rock Club**, a premier indoor climbing facility.

📍 **321 Coffee** A coffee shop with soul, 321 Coffee is dedicated to employing and empowering adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

📍 **Black & White Coffee Roasters** Founded by U.S. and World Barista Champions, this local roastery brings simply exceptional coffee to the masses.

📍 **Raleigh Beer Garden** Guinness World Record holder for most beer on tap and largest selection of beer on draught in the world.

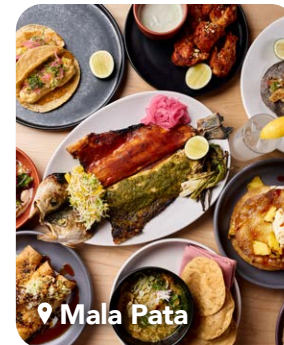
