Purpose

To inform participants of preventative measures, immediate action, response planning and capabilities associated with a variety of safety threats. Special attention is focused on workplace violence and active threats (commonly referred to as active shooters).

Presentation objectives

The objectives of this presentation focus on threat characteristics and immediate action using standard response protocols specifically outlined by the Department of Homeland Security as a common sense approach to safety during crisis events. This training will focus on the following objectives:

- 1. Provide an overview of active shooter history, initial response principles, and appropriate individual actions in an active shooter event.
- 2. Immediate recognition of an active threat or workplace violence event
- 3. Discuss the principles associated with a "Common Sense Approach to Safety"
- 4. Understand the importance of the React, Escape, Survive concept
- 5. Develop a pre-plan of appropriate actions
