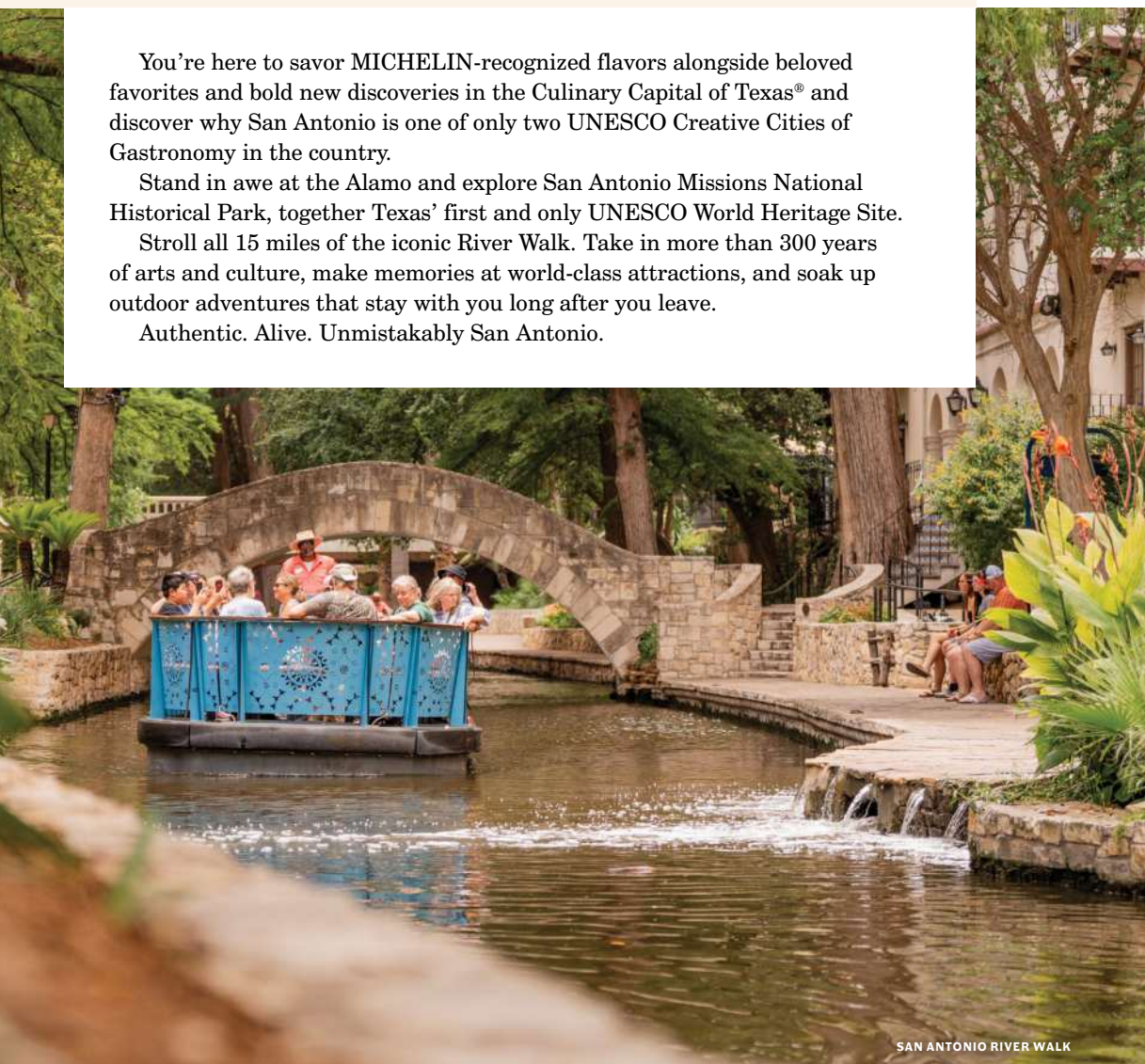

WILD NEW ADDITIONS TO THE SAN ANTONIO ZOO

Congo Falls at the **San Antonio Zoo**, billed as the world's tallest, wildest, and greatest gorilla experience, marks the return of gorillas for the first time in more than 30 years. The breathtaking two-acre rainforest habitat was designed specifically for western lowland gorillas, immersing you in the heart of Central Africa.

Rising above it all is the Mays Family Silverback Peak, the tallest gorilla tower in the world at more than 70 feet, offering sweeping views across the zoo and San Antonio's skyline.

Transformations continue with the opening of the Brewer Ocean Conservation Lab, a space dedicated to coral research, restoration, and education. The lab will showcase deep-water Texas and international coral species while offering interactive experiences that demonstrate how coral reefs are grown and restored.





CATCH ANIMAL CROSSING FUN AT SEA LIFE SAN ANTONIO

Nintendo's Animal Crossing: New Horizons Aquarium Tour swims into **SEA LIFE San Antonio** from July 30 through October 10, 2026. Throughout the aquarium, you'll spot creature facts inspired by the game, character standees, and photo opportunities on select days that bring the Animal Crossing universe to life.

SIX FLAGS FIESTA TEXAS INTRODUCES FAST LANE FOR 2026

The 2026 season brings a major update to **Six Flags Fiesta Texas** with the arrival of Fast Lane, the park's upgraded digital reservation system replacing Flash Pass. Fast Lane lets you skip regular lines and enjoy more rides and attractions with less waiting!



TAKE ON BARRACUDA STRIKE AT SEAWORLD SAN ANTONIO

SeaWorld San Antonio turns up the thrills with Barracuda Strike, the tallest inverted family coaster in North America.

Your adventure begins with a dramatic 90-foot lift hill before diving into tight turns and swooping drops at speeds up to 44 miles per hour. Inspired by the speed and agility of the barracuda, the ride delivers fast, fluid motion designed for bold first timers and seasoned thrill seekers alike.

WINGZ OF WONDER TAKES FLIGHT AT MORGAN'S WONDERLAND

Morgan's Wonderland continues to lead the way in inclusive fun with the debut of WingZ of Wonder, a first-of-its-kind tower ride. Designed with accessibility at its heart, this ride lets you soar skyward in a shared, interactive experience where riders of all abilities can feel the rush together.



RACE DOWN WASSERBAHN RACERS AT SCHLITTERBAHN

A splash-filled competition arrives at **Schlitterbahn** in 2026 with the debut of Wasserbahn Racers, a high-speed, three-lane mat racing slide built for side-by-side thrills. Start more than 37 feet in the air, then speed down a 278-foot course packed with dips and drops before a signature splashdown. A real-time stopwatch at the finish line instantly reveals the winner, giving every run bragging rights.

A NATURE PLAYScape COMING TO BRACKENRIDGE PARK

Plans are moving ahead for a nearly two-acre nature playscape at **Brackenridge Park**, built for climbing, splashing, digging, and exploring.

Designed to blend into the park's natural landscape, the space will feature water elements, an acequia-inspired channel, a sliding hill, log structures, an archaeological dig area, shaded picnic spots, and open lawn space for gathering and play.

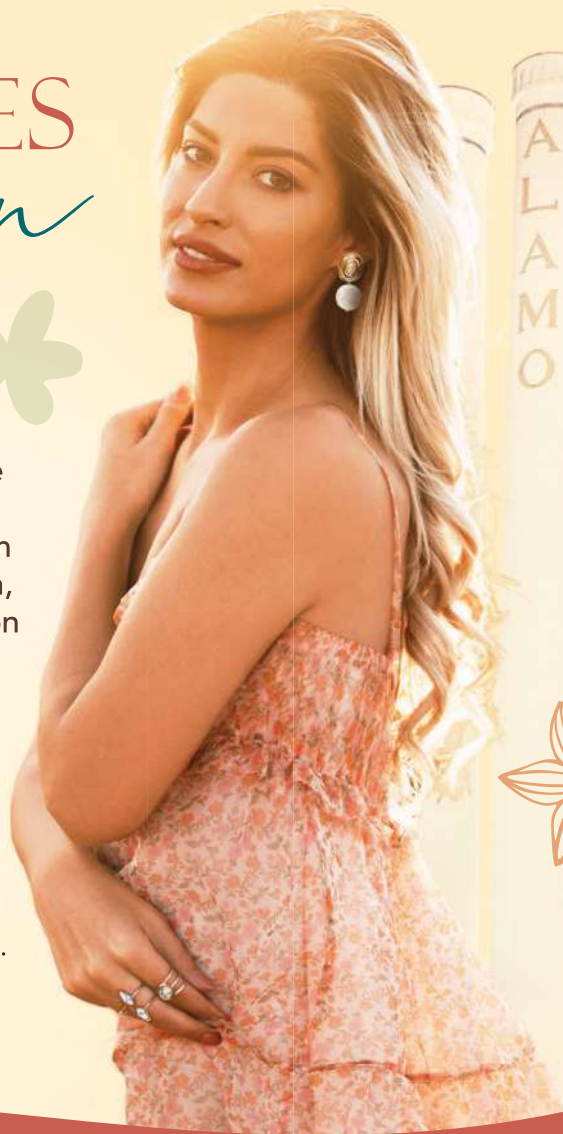

Tucked inside, **El Último** offers a speakeasy-style agave tasting experience, while **Dulce & Aroma** tempts guests with pan dulce, churros, breakfast tacos, and carajillos on tap.

Wander through the central plaza and you'll discover a tortillería, ceviche bar, frutería, Baja-style burrito stand, and a mercado stocked with artisan goods and local flavor.

DISCOVER HONKY-TONK ENERGY AT THE ROWDY SPUR

The Rowdy Spur brings honky-tonk energy to downtown with live country, Americana, and rock 'n' roll music seven nights a week, paired with Texas comfort food and classic whiskey bar vibes. Inside, keep the night going at The Karaoke Corral, a recording-studio-style sing-along space, or unwind in The Hideout, a laid-back whiskey and cigar lounge featuring poker, slots, and pool tables.



ENJOY SPOOKY FUN AT PARADISE UNKNOWN

Coming soon, **Paradise Unknown** puts a mysterious spin on the classic island cocktail bar with lush tropical drinks, an over-the-top immersive design, and just the right amount of eerie flair.

The **Institute of Texan Cultures** has reopened in a new downtown home on Houston Street, and it's not the same museum you may remember.

SAN ANTONIO BOTANICAL GARDEN

OTHERWILD BLOOMS AT THE SAN ANTONIO BOTANICAL GARDEN

On view through July 7, 2026, the **San Antonio Botanical Garden** transforms into a dreamlike landscape with *Otherwild*, an immersive art exhibit by internationally recognized artist Patrick Shearn and his studio Poetic Kinetics.

The experience unfolds in two installations. *Flora Borealis* floats above the Garden in a custom Skynet creation that moves with the breeze, mimicking the flowing motion of birds and fish. Below, *Enchanted Trees* introduces a sculptural grove of imaginary tree species, each crafted from materials that shift, reflect, and dance in the sunlight.



THE WITTE MUSEUM

CELEBRATE THE WITTE MUSEUM'S 100TH BIRTHDAY YEAR

The Witte Museum celebrates its 100th birthday with a lineup of special exhibitions and experiences that invite you to explore nature, science, and Texas culture in fresh ways.

EXPLORE UNTITLED: 20 YEARS OF COLLECTING CONTEMPORARY ART AT THE MCNAY

See what two decades of bold collecting looks like at the **McNay Art Museum** in **Untitled: 20 Years of Collecting Contemporary Art**, on view through September 6, 2026. This exhibition brings together more than 100 works spanning painting, sculpture, photography, video, and immersive installations.



LOOK TO THE STARS AT UJUĀLNĀN (GRAND SKY) AT PEARSALL PARK

A new large-scale art installation has turned Pearsall Park into a place where culture and cosmos collide. **Ujuālnān (Grand Sky)**, created by San Antonio artist Doroteo Garza, maps our solar system at an approximate 1:11 billion scale, inviting you to walk among the planets.

SEE EASTSIDE PRIDE COME TO LIFE ON NOLAN STREET

Stretching more than 600 feet along the Nolan Street underpass, **Heirlooms: Eastside Pride** transforms everyday infrastructure into a bold celebration of community and culture. Created by San Antonio artist Kaldric Dow, the mural honors the vibrancy, resilience, and self-expression that defined the Civil Rights era on the Eastside.





THE MONARCH SAN ANTONIO & LA MARIPOSA HAVE ARRIVED

Located in the reimagined **Hemisfair** District, **The Monarch San Antonio** rises 17 stories above the city as a luxury hotel inspired by the monarch butterflies that migrate through the region each year.

Dining adds even more reason to linger with four distinct concepts led by Executive Chef Jae H. Lee, whose experience spans MICHELIN-starred kitchens across the country. At lobby level, **Oak & Amber** features fire-driven cooking with bold Texas influences, while **Aleteo** pairs rooftop views with vibrant Yucatán-inspired flavors. The **Nectarie Café** offers French-inspired pastries and globally influenced dishes in a relaxed daytime setting, and the lobby bar serves craft cocktails with a caviar-forward happy hour.

At the base of the hotel, La Mariposa, a striking three-winged sculptural pavilion, is set to become one of downtown's most photographed landmarks.

THE HISTORIC EL TROPICANO COMES BACK TO LIFE AS SÍTIO

Coming fall 2026, the iconic El Tropicano, the first hotel on the River Walk, returns to downtown San Antonio as **Sítio**, reimagined with a lush, botanic redesign and immersive guest experiences. Blending its mid-century roots with a fresh vision for modern travelers, Sítio promises a distinctive stay.

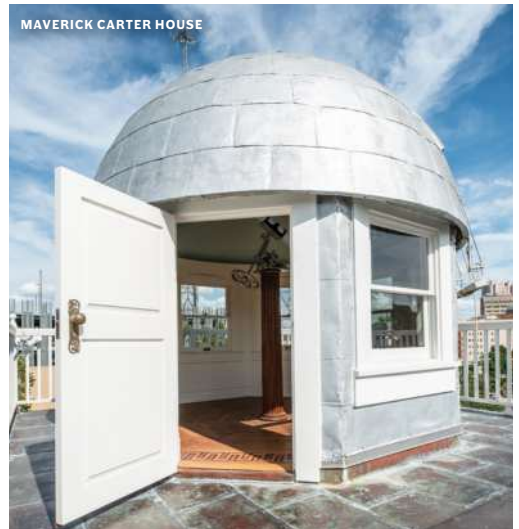
MORGAN'S HOTEL™ RAISES THE BAR FOR INCLUSIVE TRAVEL

Opening in 2026 near Morgan's Wonderland, **Morgan's Hotel™** is redefining what it means to feel truly welcome when you travel.

Designed as an Ultra-Accommodating™ hotel, this property will go beyond standard accessibility requirements with spacious guest rooms, wider hallways, barrier-free layouts, and thoughtfully designed common areas that allow for independent movement.

TAKE A TOUR AT MAVERICK CARTER HOUSE

The **Maverick Carter House**, built in 1893 along the original path of the San Antonio



River, is now open for self-guided tours. Guided and group tours are available by appointment.

Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the 23-room home was designed by renowned architect Alfred Giles and showcases striking Richardsonian Romanesque details, including rusticated stone walls, arched windows, a rounded tower, and a slate roof.

THE ALAMO'S EVOLUTION CONTINUES

Historic preservation meets forward momentum at **The Alamo**, where major enhancements are reshaping the visitor experience and creating a more welcoming journey through Texas history.

The newly opened Alamo Promenade transforms a former street into a pedestrian-friendly gateway lined with statues honoring key historical figures and shaded seating areas. Nearby, the Texas Cavaliers Education Center

expands hands-on learning opportunities for students and visitors, while Plaza de Valero offers space to relax or catch a performance.

Looking ahead, Paseo del Alamo will connect the Alamo directly to the River Walk, creating a seamless pathway between two of the city's most visited landmarks. Preservation of the historic Alamo Church continues, and the highly anticipated Alamo Visitor Center and Museum, opening in 2028, will introduce state-of-the-art exhibits and expanded storytelling.

Bud Light St. Patrick's River Parades, River Dyeing & Celebration St. Patrick's Weekend

Every March, San Antonio turns into a sea of green as the river is dyed an emerald shade with eco-friendly dye. The celebration includes live entertainment, the **Emerald Run 5K**, festive food and drinks, a lively downtown atmosphere, and more. The highlight is the **Bud Light St. Patrick's River Parade**, where themed barges float along the river with bagpipers and plenty of Irish spirit.

Pro Tip: Arrive early for a viewing spot.

Emerald Run 5K St. Patrick's Weekend

Kick off St. Patrick's Weekend with a festive 5K along the San Antonio River Walk. Runners and walkers of all levels hit the course before finishing with exclusive medals for the first 300 5K participants, costume contests, and an after-party along the river with prime views of the Bud Light St. Patrick's River Parade.

Ford Mariachi Festival During Fiesta San Antonio

The **Ford Mariachi Festival** fills the River Walk with sounds of trumpets, violins, and traditional vocals. Local Mariachi and Folklorico performers drift down the San Antonio River Walk aboard decorated barges, creating a floating concert.

Pride River Parade & Celebration May 30, 2026

The **San Antonio Pride River Parade** lights up the River Walk with a dazzling evening parade celebrating love, inclusion, and community.





Hispanic Heroes, Presented by Hennessy

September 15-30, 2026

During **Hispanic Heritage Month**, Hispanic Heroes, presented by Hennessy transforms the River Walk into a two-week illuminated art experience honoring Hispanic and Latino figures.

Rey Feo Superhero River Parade for Education

September 26, 2026

Caped crusaders and colorful floats visit the San Antonio River Walk in a high-energy celebration that supports local scholarships. Costumed characters, festive river barges, and family-friendly fun light up the water while honoring the mission of education and community leadership.



Day of the Dead San Antonio River Parade

October 23, 2026

A celebration of heritage, tradition, and remembrance, the **Day of the Dead River Parade** is one of the most visually stunning events of the year. Illuminated barges glide through downtown decorated with vibrant altars, storytelling scenes, and Catrinas. It's a beautiful tribute to **Día de Muertos**, honoring the past and celebrating life.

October 24, 2026

RIVER WALK ROYALTY

Since 1987, **River Walk Royalty** has served as year-long ambassadors for the iconic River Walk, raising funds for local hospitality and architectural preservation scholarships through the San Antonio Hospitality Foundation.

November 27, 2026

The day after Thanksgiving, the River Walk officially kicks off the holiday season with the **Ford Holiday River Parade**. Thousands of visitors gather downtown as festive floats glide along the water, accompanied by music, lights, and holiday cheer. This parade is one of San Antonio's most iconic traditions.

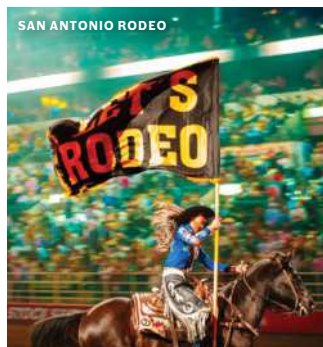

Luminaria

November 2026

A free, citywide contemporary arts festival transforming downtown with large-scale light installations, live performances, and interactive art experiences.

Winter

DreamWeek San Antonio

January 2027

A vibrant, citywide summit filled with art, dialogue, performances, and community events that celebrate diversity, civic engagement, and shared humanity.

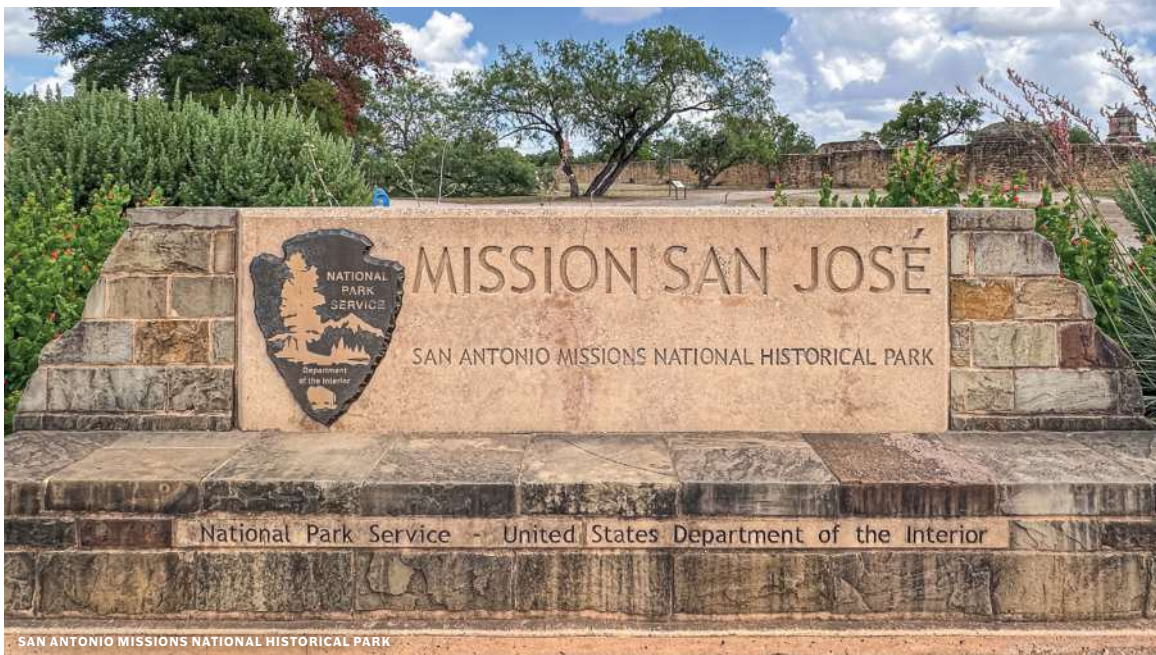
SAN ANTONIO'S LEGACY RECOGNIZED AROUND THE WORLD

A UNESCO World Heritage Experience.

San Antonio is home to the only **UNESCO World Heritage Site** in Texas. In 2015, **The Alamo** and the four Spanish colonial missions, **Mission Concepción**, **Mission San José**, **Mission San Juan**, and **Mission Espada** earned global recognition for their cultural and historic significance.

These sacred spaces reflect more than 300 years of history, continuing to shape the city today. Explore each mission, walk or bike the **Mission Reach**, and dive deeper into the designation at the **World Heritage Center**.

San Antonio's global credentials do not stop there. The city is also one of just two UNESCO Creative Cities of Gastronomy in the United States, and a member of The Food Capitals by Délice Network. *(Read more in our **Dining & Nightlife** sections.)*



THE ALAMO



THE ALAMO

More than a historic landmark, the **Alamo** is the place where Texas' story forever changed. Originally founded as Mission San Antonio de Valero in 1718, the site later became the setting of the pivotal 1836 Battle of the Alamo. Today, that legacy lives on in the heart of **downtown San Antonio**.

Step inside the Alamo Church, where the final stand took place. Admission is free, though entry tickets are required. Just beyond the church, the **Alamo Exhibit in the Ralston Family Collections Center** showcases more than 500 artifacts across 10,000 square feet of gallery space, including items from the Phil Collins Collection and the Donald and Louise Yena Spanish Colonial Collection.

For a deeper dive, book the Remember the Alamo™ Guided Tour (*additional fees apply*), led by knowledgeable Alamo History Interpreters. This 45-minute experience explores the original mission footprint across Alamo Plaza, walks through the events leading up to the battle, and includes entry to the Church, the Alamo Exhibit, and *Surrounded!*

The Alamo Augmented Experience. Spanish-language tours are offered daily.

Take time to wander the beautifully restored Plaza de Valero and Alamo Promenade, now open and designed as welcoming spaces for reflection, gathering, and live performances.

The newly opened **Texas Cavaliers Education Center** expands the Alamo's educational mission with an outdoor learning pavilion, gardens, and classroom space for student visitors.

In Summer 2026, **Paseo del Alamo** will further connect the site to the River Walk with shaded, fully ADA-accessible pathways.

Even more transformation is on the horizon. The new **Alamo Visitor Center and Museum**, opening in 2028, will feature immersive exhibits and state-of-the-art experiences that explore the site's full 300-year history.

Whether it's your first visit or your fifteenth, the Alamo continues to evolve while honoring the story that shaped Texas and inspired generations to "Remember the Alamo."



SAN ANTONIO MISSIONS NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK

Stretching along the San Antonio River, **San Antonio Missions National Historical Park** preserves four Spanish colonial missions that remain active Catholic parishes and living community landmarks today.

A member of the National Park Service, the park invites you to explore centuries of history shaped by Spanish missionaries and Indigenous communities whose influence still defines the region.

MISSION CONCEPCIÓN

Completed in 1755, Mission Concepción is the oldest unrestored stone church in the United States. Its original walls and structure have stood for more than 250 years. Each year on August 15, a remarkable solar alignment fills the church with light as the sun shines directly through the doorway and illuminates the sanctuary.



MISSION SAN JOSÉ

Often called the Queen of the Missions, Mission San José is the largest and most fully restored of the four. The intricate Rose Window remains one of the finest examples of Spanish colonial stonework in North America. The park's Visitor Center, located here, is the ideal starting point to learn about the mission system and its lasting cultural impact.



THE ACEQUIAS AND RIVER SYSTEMS

Water was essential to life at the San Antonio Missions. Beginning in 1718, Spanish settlers and Native American laborers built an extensive network of acequias, or irrigation ditches, to divert water from the San Antonio River to the missions and their farmland. Stretching nearly 15 miles and irrigating more than 3,500 acres, the system included dams, gates, and aqueducts rooted in centuries-old engineering traditions.

Several of these features remain visible today. Portions of the Acequia Madre de Valero can be seen near the Alamo and Hemisfair Park. Mission San Juan's acequia holds the oldest water right in Texas, and the Espada Dam and Aqueduct, constructed in 1745, still stand as remarkable examples of Spanish Colonial design within the national park.



MISSION SAN JUAN

Mission San Juan feels especially peaceful, surrounded by open fields and native landscapes. Once a thriving agricultural center, the mission relied on an intricate acequia irrigation system that visitors can still see today. Nearby trails along the river offer scenic walking and biking routes through this historic setting.

MISSION ESPADA

Mission Espada is the oldest of the four missions and has a distinct architectural character, including brick archways and hand-carved wooden doors. Just a short distance away, the Espada Aqueduct continues to carry water as it has for centuries, a powerful reminder of early engineering ingenuity.

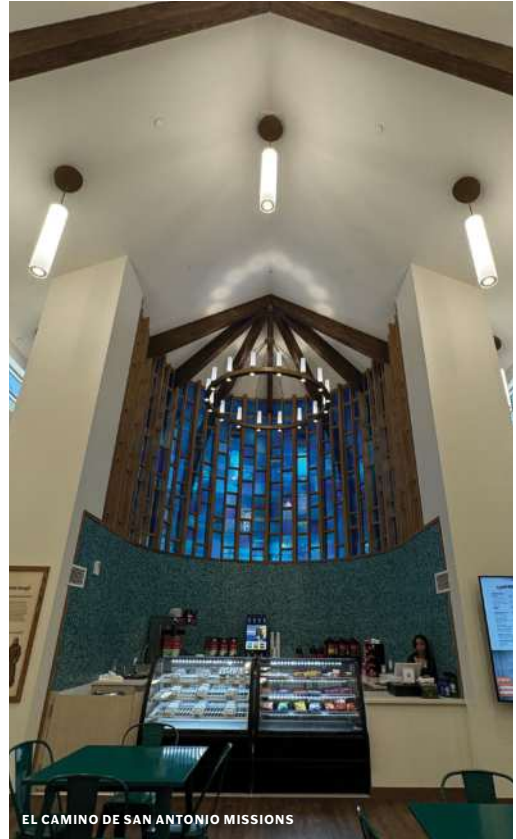


BECOME A JUNIOR RANGER

Exploring the San Antonio Missions just got even more fun. Stop by the Visitor Center at Mission San José to pick up a free Junior Ranger activity book or download one before you go. Complete the activities, learn about the missions' history and culture, and earn your official Junior Ranger badge. It's free, hands-on, and open to all ages.

Must-Dos at San Antonio Missions National Historical Park

- ✔ Start your visit at the Visitor Center at Mission San José to watch the park film and explore exhibits that bring the mission story to life.
- ✔ Join a free ranger-led program or explore at your own pace with a self-guided tour through centuries of living history.
- ✔ Bike or stroll the eight-mile Mission Reach Hike & Bike Trail, connecting all four missions with scenic river views along the way.
- ✔ Step inside for Mass at one of the active parish churches, where traditions dating back nearly 300 years continue today.
- ✔ Pause for nature. The park's native landscapes are home to diverse birdlife and wildlife throughout the year.



El Camino de San Antonio Missions and Padre Margil Pilgrimage Center

The **Padre Margil Pilgrimage Center** serves as a welcoming gateway for those embarking on the **El Camino de San Antonio Missions**, a modern-day pilgrimage route connecting San Antonio's five Spanish colonial missions.

Dedicated to Venerable Padre Antonio Margil de Jesús, a missionary known for traversing vast distances to spread his faith, the center offers visitors an immersive experience into the rich history of the missions.

Through interactive exhibits, you can delve into the lives of Padre Margil and the Franciscans who played pivotal roles in establishing these historic sites. Families will find engaging activities for children,



including a cozy Book Nook for quiet reading. Additionally, a dedicated video presentation provides insights into the pilgrimage traditions associated with the missions.

GO DEEPER INTO SAN ANTONIO'S LIVING HERITAGE

Beyond the missions themselves, several cultural sites and organizations help tell the broader story of San Antonio's World Heritage legacy.

The World Heritage Center offers exhibits and programming that connect visitors to the people and traditions tied to the missions. Nearby, the **City of San Antonio World Heritage Office and Historic Preservation Office** work to protect and promote the city's historic resources for future generations.

Downtown, the **Spanish Governor's Palace** stands as the only remaining example of Spanish colonial civil government architecture in Texas. The nearby **Casa Navarro State Historic Site** preserves the home of Tejano leader José Antonio Navarro, a signer of the Texas Declaration of Independence. At the **Bexar Heritage Center**, exhibits highlight the people and events that shaped the county's story.

At the heart of the city, **San Fernando Cathedral**, one of the oldest cathedrals in the United States, continues to serve as

an active parish while connecting visitors to centuries of faith and community life. On select nights, watch the cathedral's façade come to life during **San Antonio | The Saga**, a free 24-minute light show by international artist Xavier de Richemont that tells the story of the land, water, people, and pivotal moments that shaped San Antonio, Texas, and the United States.

Everything is bigger in Texas, including these favorites! **The Republic of Texas** serves half-pound burgers, sizzling fajitas, country-fried steak, and its signature 42-ounce margarita crafted with exclusive tequila. **Lone Star Cafe** leans fully into Texas tradition with chicken fried steak, barbecue, and classic burgers.

At **Hard Rock Cafe San Antonio**, classic American fare like burgers and sandwiches is served alongside iconic music memorabilia. For families, **Rainforest Cafe** transforms dining into an adventure, surrounding kid-friendly plates with animatronic wildlife, thunderstorm effects, and a rainforest setting that keeps little ones entertained.

Get global with your nightlife options. **Waxy O'Connor's Irish Pub & Eatery** channels traditional Irish hospitality with



pints, pub fare, and live music while **Mad Dogs British Pub** brings a classic UK pub atmosphere to the River Walk with draft beers and British staples. **Durty Nelly's Irish Pub** keeps the party going with live bands, singalongs, and a lively crowd that spills onto the patio.

Naranja Tequila & Mezcal Bar is a dedicated tequila bar on the River Walk, pouring an expertly curated lineup of blanco, reposado, añejo, and cristalino tequilas alongside an extensive mezcal selection.

FlorVino Flower Winery reimagines the wine experience with award-winning flower wines praised for their body, complexity, and velvety finish, offering something truly

distinctive in the downtown scene.

At **Howdy, Sore Loser**, step inside a neon-lit saloon and enjoy beers on tap, ranch waters, game nights, and a full kitchen serving bold bar bites.

River North Icehouse delivers a laid-back indoor-outdoor vibe inside a revitalized warehouse, with cold drinks, watch parties, arcade games, and plenty of space for sports fans and dog lovers alike. Just down the road, **1902 Nightclub** turns a restored 1890s train depot into a posh dance destination with DJ sets, bottle service, and a buzzing patio.

The Liberty Bar pairs craft cocktails and thoughtful bites inside a colorful former convent, while **The Friendly Spot Icehouse** keeps things casual with one of the city's largest beer selections and a sprawling outdoor space perfect for gathering with friends.

Casa Hernán leans into agave spirits and handcrafted cocktails in a cantina-inspired setting filled with curated art, live music, and hacienda charm while **Paseo Bar** at **Estancia del Norte** offers a polished hotel bar experience ideal for evening cocktails in a refined setting.



For high-energy fun, **Camp 1604** (21+) brings national park nostalgia to life with shaded patios, yard games, archery lanes, and more than 75 beers, wines, and cocktails. **Kung Fu Saloon** (21+) mixes vintage arcade games, free skee-ball, pickle shots, and draft cocktails into one playful party atmosphere.

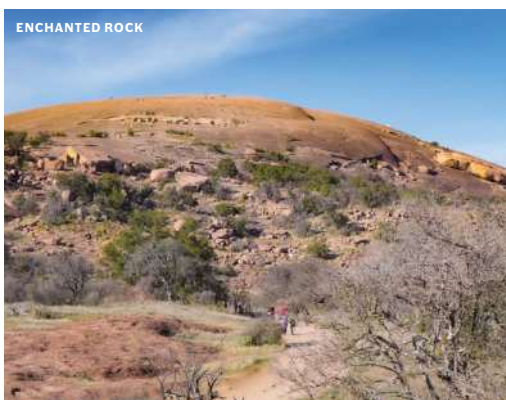
A Day in San Marcos

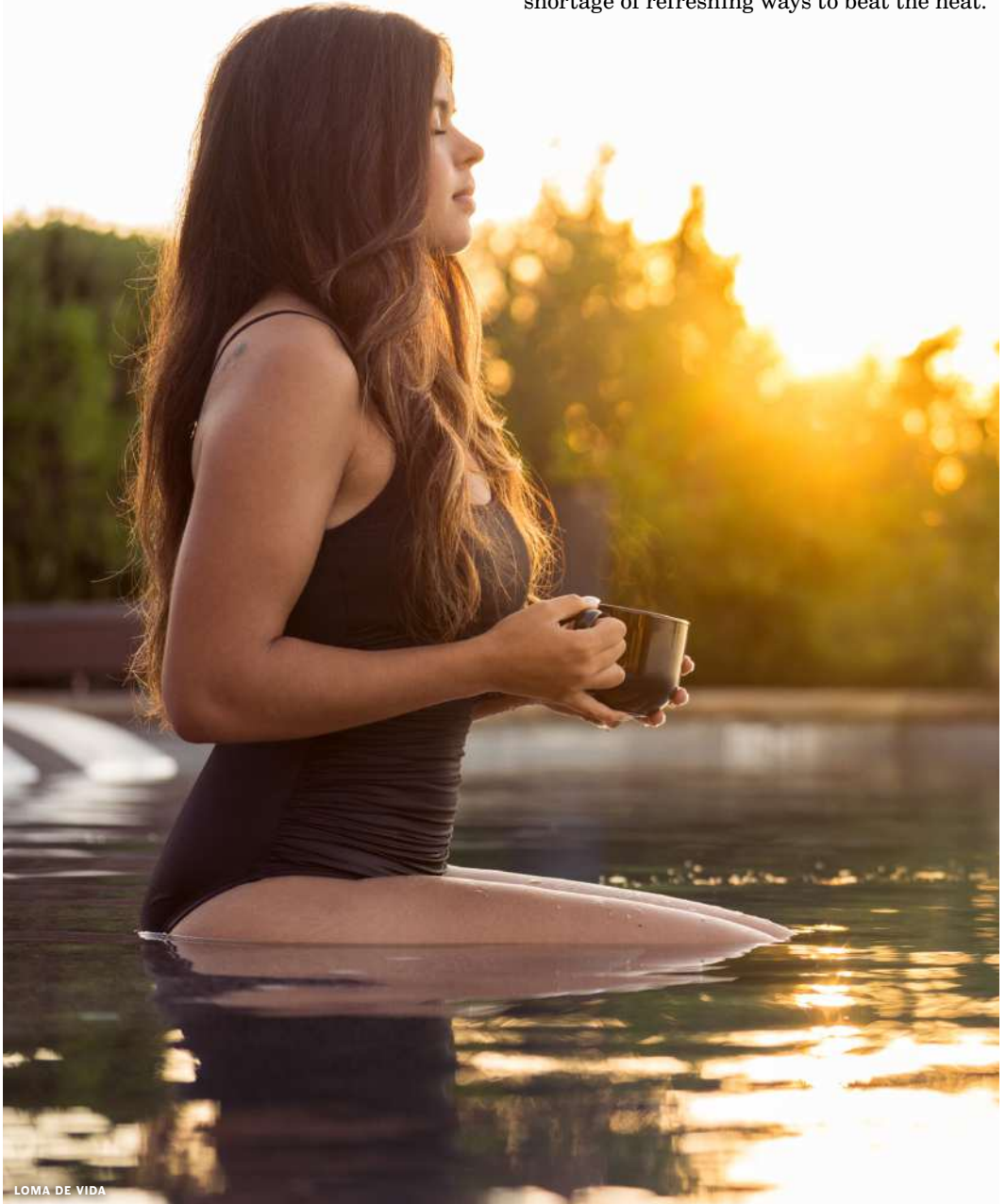
